

Early Photograph of the DAS Viscount

An early photograph of Duxford's Vickers Viscount G-ALWF being built on the production line at Weybridge in 1952 has been discovered at the Brooklands Museum. The original photograph was found by Richard Stanton, a Vickers Viscount website researcher, who also obtained permission to get a modern print produced to a professional standard. Members of the DAS Viscount team were invited to Brooklands during April to receive a copy of the photograph. Fittingly the handover took place in front of the Brooklands Viscount G-APIM and it is intended to have the photograph suitably framed and displayed on our aircraft at Duxford
